

MRV Hub Summer Academy Online Training Program 2023

Training Dates

Online participation across 6 weeks (6th June – 11th July 2023); 2 hours of training per week

Training is designed for those participants who are:

- Employed by the private or non-profit sector, who provide GHG-related data to the government for the purposes of GHG inventory estimation, mitigation action M&E, and/or carbon offset development.
- Individuals who have not yet attended MRV Hub Summer Academy, and those with little to no previous GHG management training or experience.
- Interested in learning more about GHG measurement and reporting, and how this training might help your country engage with the private-sector once completed.
- Willing to share knowledge gained with others upon training completion.

Online Section

Each online training week includes ~2 hours of training. Instruction will include homework, lectures, guest speakers, Q&A discussion forums, and a final assessment. The program requires participation in a scheduled 1-hour live lecture and 1-hour office hour.

- **Week 1:** Kick-off, the MRV Hub and academy program logistics, objectives, and overview; Introduction to GHG MRV outside of national reporting
- **Week 2:** Organizational (corporate) GHG inventory accounting
- **Week 3:** Project-level (carbon offset) GHG accounting
- **Week 4:** Quality assurance, verification, registries and carbon offset markets
- **Week 5:** National government perspective and engagement of the private sector
- **Week 6:** Closing ceremony, program evaluation, and post-assessment
